SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CRITERIA

1. Applicant must be African-American
2. Parents and student must be legal residents of the City of Carson.
Two (2) proofs of residency required (utility bills in the name of the parents).
3. Applicant must have at least a GPA of 2.5 or above in academic subjects and submit a copy of their transcript.
4. Applicant is required to submit a 300 word essay: As artificial intelligence continues to evolve and integrate into various industries, how do you anticipate it will affect your field of study and shape the trajectory of your future career? Discuss both the potential opportunities and challenges AI may present.
5. Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from a counselor, church leader, or community leader, etc., attesting to the applicant's character, community service, or academic ability.
6. The Scholarship Committee will review Application for completeness.
7. Student awardees must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA and keep CAAEC informed of their progress after each year of study. The student must submit a written request for scholarship consideration for each subsequent year.
