## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CRITERIA

- 1. Applicant must be African-American
- Parents and student must be legal residents of the City of Carson. Two (2) proofs of residency required (utility bills in the name of the parents).
- 3. Applicant must have at least a GPA of 2.5 or above in academic subjects and submit a copy of their transcript.
- 4. Applicant is required to submit a 300 word essay:Describe an individual you admire and why? Reflect on how their qualities and actions have impacted your own aspirations and values.
- 5. Applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from a counselor, church leader, community leader, etc., attesting to the applicant's character, community service, or academic ability.
- 6. The Scholarship Committee will review Application for completeness.
- 7. Student awardees must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA and keep CAAEC informed of their progress after each year of study. The student must submit a written request for scholarship consideration for each subsequent year.
